

4.0 WARRANTY & LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Metallic components of products purchased from Positech are warranted against defects in workmanship and material for a period of two (2) years from the date of delivery of the product to the first consumer.

Textile components of products purchased from Positech are warranted against defects in workmanship and material for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of delivery of the product to the first consumer.

Non-metallic and non-textile components of products purchased from Positech are warranted against defects in workmanship and material for a period of one (1) year from the date of delivery of the product to the first consumer.

Positech's obligations under this warranty are limited to replacing (transportation costs at the Dealer's expense) or repairing, at its option, any products which under normal and proper use and maintenance are proved to be defective to Positech, in its sole discretion, within the warranty period, provided that Positech has had the opportunity to inspect them.

This warranty is not transferable and only applies to the first consumer purchase through an authorized Positech dealer.

This warranty does not cover products or parts thereof which (i) normally wear out due to the general wear and tear of standard use, (ii) are modified, altered, inadequately stored or kept, or (iii) are not installed, adjusted, used or maintained in accordance with Positech's instructions. 




6.0 THE BREASTPLATE STARUS with FLEXUS





The breastplate height must allow for proper neck clearance. There must be AT LEAST 3 in. (7.5 cm) between the opening of the breastplate and the base of the neck.




NOTES:

IN ORDER NOT TO COMPRESS THE TOP OF SHOULDER, VALIDATE THAT THE HEIGHT OF THE BACKREST IS OVERALL HIGHER.








6.2 INSTALLATION AND ADJUSTMENTS






If not already done, install the headrest support.

To install the headrest support onto the structure, you must remove the upper part of the upholstered backrest cushion.




The headrest support is secured with two flat head screws from the INSIDE of the upper fixed plate towards its outside.





Set-screw under the breastplate fastener

To install the breastplate binding system, remove one of the (2) breastplate fasteners from the bar, loosen the setscrew sufficiently to allow the bar to slide in, insert the bar into the headrest support and reinsert the second breastplate fastener onto the bar.







Predrilled & centred hole



Insert the hex bolt and secure firmly.






Sit user and adjust the width between both breastplate fasteners to accommodate the upper strap portions to the shoulder width of the user.

Use the set screws located under the breastplate fasteners to secure their positions.





Open the locking clips of both breastplate fasteners and insert upper strap portions through.

WARNING:

Ensure that you have freed up the required minimum 3" (7.5cm) space from the throat of the user.

Close the locking clips.

Install the triangle Dring to the rear portion of the seat frame on each side.

Insert the strap into the triangle D-ring and secure the excess into the tri-glider sliders.

Fine-tune the adjustments by using the portion of the straps inserted into the quick-release buckle. Secure the excess into the triglider sliders.


NOTES:

FOR FURTHER ADJUSTMENTS, USE ONLY THE ADJUSTABLE STRAPS TO GENERATE THE DESIRED TENSION. ALL OTHER CONFIGURATIONS SHOULD NOT BE CHANGED.

TO FREE-UP THE USER, SIMPLY RELEASE THE QUICK-RELEASE BUCKLES AND BRING THE BREASTPLATE ABOVE THE HEAD TOWARDS THE BACK OF THE WHEELCHAIR. WHEN RESITTING THE USER, ALL THE ADJUTMENTS WILL HAVE REMAINED, SIMPLY BUCKLE THE MECHANISM TO RETRIEVE PRESET CONFIGURATIONS.




7.0 THE BREASTPLATE STARUS with BACKUS & CURVUS





The breastplate height must allow for proper neck clearance.

There must be AT LEAST 3 in. (7.5 cm) between the opening of the breastplate and the base of the neck.




NOTES:



7.2 INSTALLATION & ADJUSTMENTS

Left support: Rotation Mechanism




Fasten both supports to wheelchair cane handles onto their respective side:

On the LEFT side of the user the rotation mechanism. On the RIGHT side of the user the locking mechanism.

Ensure that both supports are paralleled to the handles.


At the LEFT extremity, tighten in moderately the mounting bar with the cap screw to measure the distance to the opposite anchor.




Cut the RIGHT extremity of the mounting bar which has all the miniatures holes to the desired length.


Secure the one hole extremity of the bar in place by tightening it with a screw.


Validate that the anchor forms a 90 °with the mounting bar.











Insert the 2 sliders.

Insert the lock and leave free 1/2" (1.27cm)

Secure the mounting bar by using the push-pull screw.

Pull the screw down, insert bar, push the screw up into the small hole of the bar to lock in place.

NOTE:

IT ALLOWS THE FOLDING OF THE WHEECHAIR.

Sit user and adjust the width between both breastplate fasteners to accommodate the upper strap portions to the shoulder width of the user.

Use the screws located under the breastplate fasteners to secure their position.


Open the clips of both breastplate fasteners and insert upper straps through the clips.

WARNING:

Ensure that you have freed up the required minimum 3" (7.5cm) space from the neck.

Close the clips.





Fasten the triangle D-rings to the rear portion of the seat frame on each side.

Insert the straps into triangle D-Rings and secure the excess length of straps into the tri-glider sliders.

Fine-tune the adjustments by using the portion of the straps inserted into the quick-release buckle. Secure the excess into the tri-glider sliders.


NOTES:

FOR FURTHER ADJUSTEMENTS, USE ONLY THE ADJUSTABLE STRAPS TO GENERATE THE DESIRED TENSION. ALL OTHER CONFIGURATIONS SHOULD NOT BE CHANGED.

TO FREE-UP THE USER, SIMPLY OPEN THE QUICK-RELEASE BUCKLES AND BRING THE BREASTPLATE ABOVE THE HEAD TOWARDS THE BACK OF THE WHEELCHAIR. WHEN RESITTING THE USER, ALL THE ADJUSTMENTS WILL HAVE REMAINED, SIMPLY BUCKLE BACK THE MECHANISM TO RETRIEVE PRESET CONFIGURATIONS.



8.0 THE BREASTPLATE STARUS CARE AND MAINTENANCE



WARNING:

DO NOT MACHINE DRY.
DO NOT STEAM AUTOCLAVE.
DO NOT DRY CLEAN.
DO NOT USE BLEACH.
DO NOT USE FABRIC SOFTENER.

Free-up the upper part of the breastplate by opening the clips and the lower part by unlocking both quick-release buckles.


Hand wash the breastplate section in cold water with a mild detergent.

Dry flat.

Ensure that both sides are completely dry, then reassemble.




9.0 THE STARUS REVERSIBLE 4-ANCHOR POINTS POSTURE BELT






9.1 THE BACK POSTURE BELT



NOTES:

USED TO BRING CLOSER THE USER'S BACK TO THE BACKREST CUSHION.


WHEN FACING THE USER, THE STARUS LOGO IS LOCATED ON THE RIGHT ILIAC CREST OF THE USER.




Loosen or tighten the adjustment mechanism Double D-ring in order to align the lateral pads over the iliac crests. Hold in place.

Determine the required length for each of the 4- anchor straps.





The superior straps should be attached at the required height (the lateral pads must stay flat on the iliac crest) to the rigid structure of the backrest or the back-frame tubes of the wheelchair. Fastened firmly.



The inferior straps should be attached to the rear portion of the structure frame of the seat.

A 45° angle should be respected while assuring that the lateral pads remain flat on the iliac crests.

Fasten firmly.


NOTES:

/USE ONLY THE QUICK-RELEASE BUCKLE TO UNLOCK THE BELT. THE SET CONFIGURATIONS WILL REMAIN AT ALL TIME.

Quick-release buckle -




9.2 THE PELVIC POSTURE BELT



NOTES:

USED TO BRING CLOSER THE USER'S PELVIC TO THE SEAT CUSHION.

WHEN FACING THE USER, THE STARUS LOGO IS LOCATED UPSIDE DOWN ON THE LEFT THIGH OF THE USER.




Turn the belt upside down.


Loosen or tighten the adjustment mechanism double D-ring in order to align the lateral pads over the thighs. Hold in place.

Determine the required length for each of the 4-anchor straps.







The superior straps should be attached at the junction of the rear part of the structure frame of the seat and the lower portion of the back canes.



The inferior straps should be attached to the side portion of the structure frame of the seat.



Fasten firmly.








10.0 THE STARUS POSTURE BELT CARE AND MAINTENANCE

WARNING:

DO NOT MACHINE DRY
DO NOT SUN DRY
DO NOT STEAM AUTOCLAVE.
DO NOT DRY CLEAN.
DO NOT USE BLEACH.
DO NOT USE FABRIC SOFTENER.



Disassemble from the wheelchair.

Hand wash in cold water with a mild detergent.

Dry flat.

Ensure that both sides are completely dry, THEN HAVE REASSEMBLED BY CLINICIAN/TECHNICIAN.
