4.0 WARRANTY & LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Metallic components of products purchased from Positech are warranted against defects in workmanship and material for a period of two (2) years from the date of delivery of the product to the first consumer.

Textile components of products purchased from Positech are warranted against defects in workmanship and material for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of delivery of the product to the first consumer.

Non-metallic and non-textile components of products purchased from Positech are warranted against defects in workmanship and material for a period of one (1) year from the date of delivery of the product to the first consumer.

Positech's obligations under this warranty are limited to replacing (transportation costs at the Dealer's expense) or repairing, at its option, any products which under normal and proper use and maintenance are proved to be defective to Positech, in its sole discretion, within the warranty period, provided that Positech has had the opportunity to inspect them.

This warranty is not transferable and only applies to the first consumer purchase through an authorized Positech dealer.

This warranty does not cover products or parts thereof which (i) normally wear out due to the general wear and tear of standard use, (ii) are modified, altered, inadequately stored or kept, or (iii) are not installed, adjusted, used or maintained in accordance with Positech's instructions. 

6.0 INSTALLATION AND ADJUSTMENTS for BACKUS & CURVUS


NOTES:

DEPENDING OF THE SIZE MODEL, YOU HAVE 3 TO 5 Tension Adjustable Canvas Straps (TACS) TO INSTALL. IN ANY CASE, THE UPPER AND LOWER TACS ARE FIXED, WHILE ALL OTHERS CAN BE MOVED UP AND DOWN FOR AN OPTIMAL ADJUSTMENT TO THE BACK PROFILE OF THE USER.





6.1 MOUNTING OF THE UPPER & LOWER TACS ONTO THE WHEELCHAIR




SPECIAL CONSIDERATION: THE MOUNTING OF THE UPPER & LOWER TACS IS IDENTICAL FOR BACKUS & CURVUS

Install the (2) triangle D-rings at the UPPER portion of the back cane while ensuring that the tip of the triangle is aiming to the outside.

Take the first pre-fixed TACS and insert them into the triangle D-ring on each side.


Insert the straps on each side of the tri-glider located in the centre of the backrest structure. Tighten the straps by pulling toward the outside and fasten to the Velcro.



Secure the LOWER pre-fixed TACS by wrapping it around the back cane on both side.

Insert, adjust to the desired tension and tighten the strap into the ladder lock buckle.





For each following movable TACS, the procedure is as follow:

Trick: To facilitate the adjustment of TACS, bring the movable rings over the Velcro strip of the structure and fasten at the desired height. You are now able to slide easily the straps to produce the desired tension adjustment.




FOR BACKUS:

Wrap around each cane the TACS. Validate the desired height and adjust as needed.

Insert, adjust to the desired tension and tighten the strap into the ladder lock buckle.

Move the rings to the centre and fix the Velcro located on the back of the TACS to the Velcro strips of the structure.





FOR CURVUS:


Wrap the TACS around each cane. Validate the height and adjust as needed according to the gibbosity.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATION: Used the quantity of TACS required to provide the optimal fit and support according to the back's profile.

Insert, adjust to the desired tension and tighten the straps into the ladder lock buckles.

Move back the rings to the centre and fix the Velcro located on the back of the TACS to the Velcro strips of the structure.

6.2 INSTALLATION OF THE UPHOLSTERED BACKREST



SPECIAL CONSIDERATION: IF YOU INTEND TO INSTALL AXILUS. PLEASE REFER TO ITS INSTRUCTION & CARE MANUAL BEFORE CONTINUING.

FOR BACKUS:

Fasten the upholstered backrest using the lateral Velcro flaps (4) to connect with the Velcro strip located on the structure and secured the straps into the ladder lock buckles.


Once installed, finalized the tension adjustment of ALL the straps.

FOR CURVUS:

Fasten the upholstered backrest using the lateral Velcro flaps to connect with the Velcro strips (6) located on the structure and secured the straps into the ladder lock buckles.


Once installed, finalized the tension adjustment of ALL straps.





Bring back the finishing flap to close the rear of the backrest and secure at the bottom with the Velcro closure.

7.0 CLEANING CARE OF THE UPHOLSTERED BACKREST COVER



WARNING:

DO NOT IMMERSE THE COMPLETE UPHOLSTERED BACKREST IN WATER.

Unzip the opening of the cover to retrieve the foam insert. Store the foam in a secured place.

Trick: Fold the foam inside the fabric cover, making it smaller and easier to extract and insert.

Hand wash in cold water with a mild detergent. Dry flat.

Ensure that both sides (inside and outside) are completely dry.

WARNING:

DO NOT MACHINE DRY OR SUN DRY.
DO NOT STEAM AUTOCLAVE.
DO NOT DRY CLEAN.
DO NOT USE FABRIC SOFTENER OR BLEACH.

Reassemble once it is COMPLETELY dry. In between monthly cleaning, the cover and the backrest structure should be wiped down with a slightly dampened cloth and let to air dry.
