

## 4.0 WARRANTY & LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Metallic components of products purchased from Positech are warranted against defects in workmanship and material for a period of two (2) years from the date of delivery of the product to the first consumer.

Textile components of products purchased from Positech are warranted against defects in workmanship and material for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of delivery of the product to the first consumer.

Non-metallic and non-textile components of products purchased from Positech are warranted against defects in workmanship and material for a period of one (1) year from the date of delivery of the product to the first consumer.

Positech's obligations under this warranty are limited to replacing (transportation costs at the Dealer's expense) or repairing, at its option, any products which under normal and proper use and maintenance are proved to be defective to Positech, in its sole discretion, within the warranty period, provided that Positech has had the opportunity to inspect them.

This warranty is not transferable and only applies to the first consumer purchase through an authorized Positech dealer.

This warranty does not cover products or parts thereof which (i) normally wear out due to the general wear and tear of standard use, (ii) are modified, altered, inadequately stored or kept, or (iii) are not installed, adjusted, used or maintained in accordance with Positech's instructions. In addition to the foregoing, this warranty does not cover punctures, tears, or burns, exposure to moisture, exceeding the weight limit and <acts of nature> (ex. Flood, Earthquake, Tornado, etc.). Any substitutions of supplied hardware also void the warranty.

THE FOREGOING IS POSITECH'S SOLE WARRANTY, ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING WARRANTIES OF FITNESS FOR PURPOSE AND MERCHANTABILITY, ARE EXCLUDED AND DISCLAIMED TO THE FULL EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW. IN NO EVENT SHALL THE DEALER BE ENTITLED TO MORE THAN THE PRICE OF THE PURCHASED PRODUCTS AT THAT TIME AS FINAL PENALTY AND DAMAGE. #### WARRANTY SERVICE

Owner is responsible for all costs associated with returning Product to Positech innovation Inc. for service. 
#### 6.2 INSTALLATION AND ADJUSTMENTS



SPECIAL CONSIDERATION:
The user is not to be sitting in the wheelchair during the fixation of the hardware components.

To install the headrest support to the upper fixed plate, you must remove the upper part of the upholstered backrest.


The headrest support is secured with two flat head screws from the INSIDE of the upper fixed plate towards its outside.




To memorize the desired height, a height lock is secured by tightening its socket setscrew.

A lobe knob locks the headrest stem to the headrest support.






Slightly loosen the three (3) flange bolts to make multidirectional adjustments: front/back, lateral, rotational.



The flange bolt closest to the headrest cushion provides extra rotation for optimal posture of the head.



Slightly loosen the slant screw to change the headrest angle.


Tighten all screws and bolts firmly.



#### 7.2 INSTALLATION & ADJUSTMENTS




Left extremity
Moderate tightening

Lock

+½"

Final tightening



Fasten both supports to wheelchair cane handles onto their respective side:

On the LEFT side of the user the rotation mechanism. On the RIGHT side of the user the locking mechanism.

Ensure that both supports are paralleled to the handles.

At the LEFT extremity, tighten in moderately the mounting bar with the cap screw to measure the distance to the opposite anchor.


## ADD to this measurement 1/2" (1.27 cm).

Cut the RIGHT extremity of the mounting bar which has all the miniatures holes to the desired length.

Secure the one hole extremity of the bar in place by tightening it with a screw.

Validate that the anchor forms a 90 °with the mounting bar.









Insert the lock and leave free 1/2" (1.27cm)

Secure the mounting bar by using the push-pull screw.

Pull the screw down, insert bar, push the screw up into the small hole of the bar to lock it in place.




Insert the stem in the headrest support.




To memorize the desired height, a height lock is secured by tightening its socket set-screw.

A lobe knob locks the headrest stem to the headrest support.






Slightly loosen the flange bolts to make multidirectional adjustments: front/back, lateral, rotational.



The flange bolt closest to the headrest cushion provides extra rotation for optimal posture of the head.



Slightly loosen the slant screw to change the headrest angle.

Tighten screws and bolts firmly.



## 8.0 CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF THE COVER

#### **SPECIAL CONSIDERATION:**

THESE INSTRUCTIONS ARE VALIDE WHEN SUMMUS CUSHIONS ARE USED WITH FLEXUS, BACKUX & CURVUS BACKRESTS



DO NOT IMMERSE SUMMUS.


Unzip the cover and remove gently.

Hand wash in cold water with a mild detergent. Dry flat. Ensure that both sides are completely dry.



DO NOT MACHINE DRY.
DO NOT SUN DRY.
DO NOT STEAM AUTOCLAVE.
DO NOT DRY CLEAN.
DO NOT USE BLEACH.
DO NOT USE FABRIC SOFTENER.

Reassemble when fully dry.
