Inform the User :

- To **NEVER** modify the set adjustments made by you, Dealer & Clinician.
- To immediately discontinue use if any function is compromised, parts are missing, loose, or shows signs of excessive wear.

If you feel discomfort, please contact your qualified clinician to discuss your concerns. If your condition changes with time, please visit your qualified clinician for new adjustment settings.

Positech innovation products are specifically designed and manufactured for use in conjunction with Positech innovation accessories. Accessories designed by other manufacturers have not been tested by Positech innovation and are not recommended for use with Positech innovation products.

Before using FLEXUS, the clinician should teach you and/or the caregiver why & how the required support of the back obtained, how to manipulate the backrest system, its proper adjustments & the safety rules. Not receiving the proper training may result into discomfort or severe injury.

Before each use of FLEXUS, ensure that FLEXUS is fully functional by conducting a thorough check of all hardware components and fasteners. If loose, secure the components to the initial torque settings while **RESPECTING THE ORIGINAL INSTALLATION CONFIGURATIONS**. In addition, verify that all hardware components and the backrest upholstered cushion do not show substantial deterioration. If this verification process is not done correctly, a risk of equipment breakdown, damage to components and/or user injury could occur.

All accessories or replacement parts not provided by Positech innovation may not be used in conjunction with our FLEXUS backrest system as it may affect negatively its performance, cause safety issue and void the warranty.

3.0 WARRANTY & LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

Metallic components of products purchased from Positech are warranted against defects in workmanship and material for a period of two (2) years from the date of delivery of the product to the first consumer.

Textile components of products purchased from Positech are warranted against defects in workmanship and material for a period of ninety (90) days from the date of delivery of the product to the first consumer.

Non-metallic and non-textile components of products purchased from Positech are warranted against defects in workmanship and material for a period of one (1) year from the date of delivery of the product to the first consumer.

Positech's obligations under this warranty are limited to replacing (transportation costs at the Dealer's expense) or repairing, at its option, any products which under normal and proper use and maintenance are proved to be defective to Positech, in its sole discretion, within the warranty period, provided that Positech has had the opportunity to inspect them.

This warranty is not transferable and only applies to the first consumer purchase through an authorized Positech dealer.

This warranty does not cover products or parts thereof which (i) normally wear out due to the general wear and tear of standard use, (ii) are modified, altered, inadequately stored or kept, or (iii) are not installed, adjusted, used or maintained in accordance with Positech's instructions. In addition to the foregoing, this warranty does not cover punctures, tears, or burns, exposure to moisture, exceeding the weight limit and <acts of nature> (ex. Flood, Earthquake, Tornado, etc.). Any substitutions of supplied hardware also void the warranty.

THE FOREGOING IS POSITECH'S SOLE WARRANTY, ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING WARRANTIES OF FITNESS FOR PURPOSE AND MERCHANTABILITY, ARE EXCLUDED AND DISCLAIMED TO THE FULL EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW. 

5.2 FLEXUS STRUCTURE COMPONENTS



FLEXUS is made of a fully adjustable rigid structure (hardware) covered by an upholstered backrest cushion.



WARNING :
AT ANY TIME, DO NOT MODIFY THE PRESCRIBED ADJUSTMENTS OF YOUR CLINICIAN MADE AT THE INSTALLATION.

If you need to remove the entire backrest from the wheelchair, **THE USER SHOULD NOT BE SITTING IN THE WHEELCHAIR.**

Open the safety latches located on each side of the wheelchair and pull up and out the **COMPLETE** system.




6.1 REMOVAL OF UPHOLSTERED BACKREST CUSHION





While accomplishing the following task, the patient ***should not be sitting*** on the wheelchair.




Unzip the 2 small zippers of the back-closing flap.

Untie completely both straps holding the upholstered backrest in place.



Lift the top flap to access the lateral fabric flaps located on either side of the backrest top.

Pull on the lateral fabric flaps to free them from the Velcro closure.



Gentle extract from the TOP of the wheelchair the entire upholstered backrest.

6.2 UPHOLSTERED COVER CARE INSTRUCTIONS





WARNING :

WARNING :

**DO NOT MACHINE DRY.
DO NOT STEAM AUTOCLAVE.
DO NOT DRY CLEAN.
DO NOT USE BLEACH.
DO NOT USE FABRIC SOFTENER.**



Unzip the whole length of the cover.

Remove gently the foam insert.

Remove the metal rod and the straps.

**SPECIAL CONSIDERATION:
Store foam, metal rod and straps in a SAFE place.**

Hand wash in cold water with a mild detergent.


Dry flat.

Ensure that both sides are completely dry, then reassemble.

6.3 INSTALLATION OF UPHOLSTERED BACKREST CUSHION



While accomplishing the following task the patient should not be sitting on the wheelchair.



Before installing the upholstered backrest cushion, conduct a thorough check of all fasteners and secure any loose components following the required torque settings. IF YOU ARE UNCERTAIN ABOUT THE SAFETY, CONTACT IMMEDIATELY YOUR CLINICIAN / DEALER FOR ASSISTANCE.

Insert the lower part of the upholstered backrest cushion in between the lower edge of the structure and the seat cushion.

Bring the lateral flaps onto the Velcro patches of the structure and secure.

Align the top flap opening with the headrest fastener location.

Slip end of straps under the elastic cord and insert in their respective D-ring.

Tighten the straps.

Zip the 2 small zippers of the back-closing flap into place and slide under the elastic cord.
